



FAQ about your SCOPE commitment

Does every family need to donate to the SCOPE auction?

Yes, each family at OLSOS has a SCOPE obligation. The obligation can be kept by donating an item, or items, of \$100 + value.

What kind of items do I donate?

New or handmade items will be accepted. Try to think of items that will generate great interest at the auction. Theme baskets, tickets to sporting events, theater tickets, vacation packages, services, sacred art, electronics, and gift certificates are some of the possibilities. The goal of the SCOPE auction is to make money for the school. If you have any questions or need help, please don't hesitate to ask.

Do I need to create a theme basket?

No, you can donate single items or a group of items. If you're not comfortable with your packaging skills, the SCOPE committee would be happy to help.

When are the donation items due?

There are 3 deadline dates for the SCOPE auction:

- Submit your donation on or before December 10th and you will receive 2 fundraising hours.
- Submit your donation between December 10th and February 25th you will receive 1 fundraising hour.
- Donations will NOT be accepted after April 30th.

Where do I deliver my donation item?

Bring your auction item to the school office. You will be asked to complete a procurement form. This form will ensure that you receive credit for your donation and will help at tax time. When completing the procurement form, be sure to accurately describe and assign a value to the item.

Why do the items need to be submitted before April 30th?

Once donations are submitted, the SCOPE committee needs time to process and prepare the item for the auction.
